Memory Verse: "This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God."– 1 Corinthians 4:1

Mon - Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-2. Servants (literally under-rower as in a rower in a slave ship below deck) and stewards (the manager, not the owner, of an estate) are the two ways we are to view church leaders. How do these two perspectives balance each other? How can this view be cultivated and encouraged?

Tue - Read 1 Corinthians 4:3-7; Romans 14:4. What three "courts" does Paul say he must face? What insights about properly facing evaluations can we learn here? How should our union with Jesus Christ shape our perspective on being evaluated?

Wed - Read 1 Corinthians 4:8-13; 1 Thessalonians 5:12-15. What are the main points Paul is making in this passage? How do you sometimes resemble the Corinthians when you consider those who labor on your behalf?

Thu - Read 1 Corinthians 4:14-17; Acts 18:1-11. Why does Paul address them with the father/children image? In what ways does he call the Corinthian Christians to imitate him? Why? What are the implications for us?

Fri - Read 1 Corinthians 4:18-21. Shepherding requires a tender heart and a strong love for God's will, and for the persons involved. What ways have you supplied the rod of discipline and received the rod of discipline, in your walk with Christ?

Sat - Read 1 Corinthians 5:1-13. Prepare for tomorrow by seeking God's Holy Spirit to help you understand the passage.. Bring someone you know who needs to hear the gospel to tomorrow's service.
