Spare the Rod and Spoil the Church (Part 2)

1 Corinthians 5:1-13

Memory Verse: “But actually I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother if he should be an immoral person, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard or a swindler – not even to eat with such a one.”— 1 Corinthians 5:11

Note: Each day this week you will be completing the chart on the insert provided. Please read the Scriptures listed for the day, as found on the chart, and fill-out all three columns; problem, process and purpose.

Mon – Read 1 Corinthians 5:1-13; 2 Corinthians 2:5-11; Matthew 18:15-20. How do these passages confirm one of the main purposes of discipline?

Tue – Read Luke 17:3-4; Romans 16:17-20; Galatians 2:11-14. In what ways do these passages tell us problems of sin are common to all believers?

Wed - Read Galatians 6:1-5; 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-15. Does the process involve both parties being humble? In what ways do you see it in the passages?

Thu - Read 1 Timothy 5:19-20; 2 Timothy 2:23-26; Titus 1:10-16. What are the different problems Paul says require discipline in these passages?

Fri - Read Titus 3:9-11; 2 John 9-11; 3 John 9-10. Is the process modified for some problems? Why?

Sat - Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-11. The patterns for a healthy church, being humbly dependent upon God and each other, can be found here. Reflect on the implications of this passage for your life, and ready your hearts for worship tomorrow.
