**1 Corinthians 3:10 - 23**

1. The Church's One Foundation (vv. 10-11)

2. Three Types of Work (vv. 10b, 12-17)

**Memory Verse:** "According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it. For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ." – 1 Corinthians 3:10, 11

**Monday** - Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-11. Our foundation is Christ Jesus, and we are responsible to build upon that foundation. What ways have you been building upon that foundation, and what are some ways that the Spirit may be convicting you to build differently?

**Tuesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 3:12-15; 1 Corinthians 9:15-18; Matthew 19:27-30. Is it right for a Christian to think in terms of rewards for work in the Kingdom? Why or why not? What kinds of things are likely to remain after the test of "fire?"

**Wednesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; Romans 8:12-17; 1 Peter 2:4-5, 9-10. What are the many implications that flow from the truth that believers are indwelt by the Holy Spirit? How should these affect the way we live and enter into relationships with people?

**Thursday** - Read 1 Corinthians 3:18-20; 1 Corinthians 2:6-8; Isaiah 55:8-9. What are some of the circumstances where you applied the wisdom of this world, and questioned what God was doing in your life? How did God show you that His ways are higher than your ways?

**Friday** - Read 1 Corinthians 3:21-23. What does Scripture mean by "all things belong to you?" How is that related to verse 23, and in what ways might our behavior change if we really believe this?

**Saturday** - Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-21. Write a short summary of the argument Paul is making here, in preparation for tomorrow's sermon. Pray that God would speak clearly to those who hear the message.
