## Saved to Sin No More

### 1 Corinthians 6:1-11

**Narrow Point:** Foolishly lay down your rights, anticipating our future reality. 1 Corinthians 6:1-8

**Broader Point:** Joyfully pursue obedience, remembering God's extravagant grace. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11

**Memory Verse:** "Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God"— 1 Corinthians 6:11

**Mon** – Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-3. Paul's preference is for Christians not to rely on the judgement of non-Christians in disputes. What then are the recourses open to Christians for resolving disputes?

**Tue** – Read 1 Corinthians 6:4-6. Have you ever thought to have a dispute settled by bringing in a third party Christian to decide what is fair? Why or why not?

**Wed** - Read 1 Corinthians 6:7-8. Why is it "already a defeat for you" to have lawsuits against brothers in Christ? Why should you be willing to be wronged? How do you feel about this rather revolutionary call to sacrificial love?

**Thu** - Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-10. What are some sins, whether they are in this passage or not, that have been difficult for you to gain victory over? How can you battle against these areas in light of the gospel?

**Fri** - Read 1 Corinthians 6:11. Are you convinced that you are washed, sanctified and justified in the name of Christ? In what ways does meditating on that truth help you with persistent sin patterns?

**Sat** - Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20. Reflect on the fact that you have been bought with a price, and prepare your heart for worship tomorrow.
