# From Disappointment to Delight

**Memory Verse:** “<sup>25</sup> And He said to them, “O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?” – Luke 24:25-26

**Monday** - Read Luke 24:13-19a. Can you identify with the disappointment these two on the road experienced? What do you learn about Jesus and how he helps us with our disappointments?

**Tuesday** - Read Luke 24:19b-21. The two on the road were disappointed that Jesus did not redeem Israel yet they are speaking with the risen Jesus who had done just that. What lessons about walking with Jesus can you draw from this?

**Wednesday** - Read Luke 24:8-12, 22-24. What does the account reveal about what God was seeking to accomplish in these followers of Jesus? What do you think God is seeking to do in your life in a similar way?

**Thursday** - Read Luke 24:25-31 and John 5:39. How did Jesus reveal himself to the two in the account and how does that correspond to how He reveals himself to us today? How does this shape your view of the Old Testament?

**Friday** - Read Luke 24:31-35. Why do you think Jesus vanished – what was his purpose? Trace the use of the following terms through the text (one another, our, us, they, those, them). What insights do you draw from the use of these terms on how we can experience Jesus today?

**Saturday** – Read Luke 24:36-53. Reflect on Jesus’ sending forth the promise of the Father, the Holy Spirit. Prepare your hearts to worship the Lord in spirit and truth.
