Always Start Here

1 Corinthians 1:1-9

Memory Verse: God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.— **1 Corinthians 1:9**

Mon - Read 1 Corinthians 1:1. What does it mean to be “called...by the will of God?” Like Paul, how have you experienced a call by God, either in the same direction as your will, or in contradiction to your will?

Tues - Read 1 Corinthians 1:2-3. We were sanctified (made holy) in Christ Jesus, and are now called *Saints* by Him. In what ways should this realization affect our view of the seriousness of sin, as well as the lavishness of grace?

Wed - Read 1 Corinthians 1:4-7. Christ’s free grace has set us apart, made us saints and sanctified in Him. Do we eagerly await the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ? What does that look like in our everyday lives?

Thurs - Read 1 Corinthians 1:8 and 6:19-20. What is “the day of our Lord Jesus Christ?” How are we held “blameless” in the end? How do these passages affect our view of who and whose we really are?

Fri - Read 1 Corinthians 1:9 and Colossians 3:1-4. What do these passages say about our new life and identity? What are some of the effects of this truth on our relationship with God and others?

Sat – Read 1 Corinthians 1:10-17. Make notes on the meaning of this passage in preparation for worship tomorrow. Bring someone who may have attended our Christmas service to the worship service tomorrow.
