Memory Verse: “For the wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does.” – 1 Corinthians 7:4.

Monday - Read 1 Cor 7:1; Genesis 1:27-28. The Corinthians believed they were being especially holy by promoting the principle in this verse. What are some ways you can refute that principle from Scripture?

Tuesday - Read 1 Cor 7:2-3. What could be some of the circumstances under which a husband or wife might not give the other their “conjugal rights,” in disobedience of this command of Scripture?

Wednesday - Read 1 Cor 7:4-5; Genesis 2:20-25. What are the reasons that Paul gives for not depriving each other within the context of marriage? Under what conditions is it permissible to do so?

Thursday - Read 1 Cor 7:6-7, 32-35. In what ways might singleness be a gift from God to the unmarried man and woman, and how can it be used for His glory?

Friday - Read 1 Cor 7:8-9. What reasons would you give to defend both the single and the married life as a part of God’s design for human sexuality?

Saturday - Read 1 Cor 7:10-24. Read the passage and write down the main ideas in preparation for tomorrow’s service. Ask God in prayer to touch our hearts with the true Gospel message.
