## Let's Experience God This Easter

### Ephesians 2:1-10

#### Face the \_\_\_\_\_

##### Ephesians 2:1-3

And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. <sup>3</sup> Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.

#### Depend on God's

##### Ephesians 2:4-9

<sup>4</sup> But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), <sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus, <sup>7</sup> so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. <sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; <sup>9</sup> not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

#### Join God in His \_\_\_\_\_

##### Ephesians 2:10

<sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

**Memory Verse** – “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.” – Ephesians 2:8, 9

**Monday** - Read Ephesians 2:1-3. What does it mean to be “by nature children of wrath,” and in what ways are believers no longer children of wrath?

**Tuesday** - Read Ephesians 2:4, 5. What attributes of God are either explicitly or implicitly made known to us by these two verses? How should your heart respond?

**Wednesday** - Read Ephesians 2:6-7. What are the implications for the life of a believer who recognizes he/she is already “raised up and seated in the heavenly places,” for the purpose of showing God’s immeasurable grace?

**Thursday** - Read Ephesians 2:8, 9. Name at least four (4) essential points of God’s redemptive plan that can be drawn from these two verses.

**Friday** - Read Ephesians 2:10. In your own words, construct a simple explanation of the relationship between doing good things and being saved by God, so that an unbeliever can understand.

**Saturday** - Read 1 Corinthians 9:1-18. Reflect on the text and it’s call to use your rights well. Pray for God to show you who He would have you invite to hear the Gospel preached this week.
