## 1 Corinthians 11:2-16

**Memory Verse** – “However, in the Lord, neither is woman independent of man, nor is man independent of woman. For as the woman originates from the man, so also the man has his birth through the woman; and all things originate from God.” - 1 Corinthians 11:11-12.

**Monday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:2-3; John 1:1; Philippians 2:5-8. What are some ways that Christ’s submission (although being God Himself) to the headship of the Father should shape our view of men’s and women’s roles?

**Tuesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:4-10; Genesis 2:22-23. What are the cultural illustrations in this passage, and what are the universal principles found here?

**Wednesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:11-12; Genesis 1:27-31. What are some of the ways, in a practical sense, that husband and wife can image the triune God?

**Thursday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:13-15; 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What would be a universal principle that God wants to teach us from these verses?

**Friday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:16; Acts 17:10-13; Hebrews 13:17-18. What are some godly ways that we are called to behave when disagreements over practice occur within the church?

**Saturday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:2-16 and 1 Timothy 2:9-14. Spend time in prayer preparing your hearts to hear the message tomorrow. Pray for the church, that God would grant understanding of His ways, and submit to them for His glory.
