

Male and Female in the Worshipping Church (Part 2)

Genesis 2:15 - 3:7; 1 Timothy 2:8-15 - 3:1

Memory Verse – “Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” Genesis 1:26.

Monday - Read Genesis 2:15-17. What are some of the implications for family life that can be derived from God’s command to Adam, (before Eve was created) in these verses?

Tuesday - Read Genesis 2:18-20; Genesis 1:27, 28. God’s “discovery” that there was no helper suitable for Adam among the things created up to that point, and his creation of Eve from Adam’s flesh, tells us several things about His view of women. What are some of them?

Wednesday - Read Genesis 2:21-24. God’s restoration, in marriage, of the ‘one flesh’ of man and woman has far reaching effects on our beliefs. What are some of them related to human dignity and worth?

Thursday – Read 1 Timothy 2:1-7, 8-10. What are the reasons that God establishes roles, as outlined here, for men and women, according to these verses, (to what does “therefore” refer)?

Friday – Read 1 Timothy 2:11-15, 3:1. Identify the differing roles for men and women outlined by Paul in these verses. Upon what does Paul base these distinctions?

Saturday - Read 1 Corinthians 11:17-34. Reflect upon the privilege of the Lord’s Supper as an ordinance, and pray to prepare your heart to hear from God’s word tomorrow.
