

## Connection

### 1 Corinthians 11:17-34

**Memory Verse** – “When He had given thanks, He broke it and said, ‘This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.’ In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.’ ” – 1 Corinthians 11:24, 25.

**Monday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:17-19. When we gather together, are you aware of any factions or divisions among our church family, and in what ways do you contribute to them?

**Tuesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:20-22. In what ways does selfishness or concern for self alone manifest itself in your daily life and break our connections to others? Take some time to repent of these behaviors.

**Wednesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. What are some of the truths that we can remember when called to connect with Christ through communion? What does communion remind us about our future in Christ?

**Thursday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:27-32. What sins has the Holy Spirit made you aware of that require repentance prior to taking communion? Ask God to cause true repentance so that you can be granted forgiveness and take communion in a worthy manner.

**Friday** - Read 1 Corinthians 11:33, 34. In what specific ways does a proper understanding of the Lord’s Supper change us, especially with respect to connecting with our brothers and sisters in Christ, and with Christ Himself?

**Saturday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:1-11. Reflect upon the truths found in this passage and how they apply to you. Pray that tomorrow’s service will bring glory to God and edification to all who participate.
