**Memory Verse** – “ Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord. There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons.” – 1 Corinthians 12:4-6.

**Monday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:1-3. What are some practices or beliefs that you have that may be from your pre-Christian past, or from your previous understanding of the Scriptures, that need to be corrected or avoided?

**Tuesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-6. In what ways is the Trinity represented in these verses, and how do the Spirit, the Lord Jesus and God the Father interact with your gifting?

**Wednesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:7. What are some ways you are using your spiritual gifts to serve the Universal or local church? How could you use them better?

**Thursday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:8-10; Romans 12:4-8; 1 Corinthians 14:1-4. What are some gifts that if used incorrectly, might not edify the church? What are some that edify the church?

**Friday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:11. How should the Spirit's personal decision to gift you for the body affect your prayers and your devotions?

**Saturday** - Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-31. As you consider your own spiritual gifts this week, write down a few application points you might hear in tomorrow's sermon. Bring someone from your FRAN (Friends, Relatives, Associates and Neighbors) to church tomorrow.
