**Memory Verse:** "So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek to abound for the edification of the church." – 1 Corinthians 14:12.

**Monday** - Read 1 Corinthians 14:1-5; Ephesians 4:15, 16. Identify at least two ways you can practically edify others in the church family this week and do it.

**Tuesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 14:6-12. What are some ways that you can develop your spiritual gifts so that they can be employed better or more often to edify the church?

**Wednesday** - Read 1 Corinthians 14:13-25; 2 Timothy 3:16, 17. Share some Scripture truths with others in the Cherrydale family this week and do your best to make it clear and encouraging.

**Thursday** - Read 1 Corinthians 14:26-33. What are some ways that edifying the body when we gather requires order and structure?

**Friday** - Read 1 Corinthians 14:34-40; Genesis 2:15-18, 20-25; 1 Timothy 2:11-14. Carefully examine the context of the instructions Paul gave to women in the Corinthian church and discover why he would give this restriction.

**Saturday** - Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. Reflect on what these verses say about the Gospel in all its fullness, in preparation for tomorrow's service. Bring someone who has not heard, or has not responded to the Gospel of Christ to the service.
