Psalm 113:6-9

Praise God for who you are in Christ

The phrases "in Christ", "in the Lord" and "in Him" are used 160 times in the New Testament. A study of these reveal over 50 things that are true about you as a believer in Christ. The biblical pattern is to first tell us who we are in Christ and then to exhort us to live our identity by faith in the power of the Holy Spirit. For example, read Romans 6-8; Ephesians 1-3, and Colossians 1- 3 and praise God for your indemnity in Christ.

Praise God for the work of the Holy Spirit in you

1. Regenerates (Titus 3:5; John 3:5, 8)
2. Baptized with (1 Cor. 12:13)
3. Sealed with (Ephesians 1:13; 4:30)
4. Indwells forever (1 Corinthians 6:19-20; John 14:16)
5. Anointed with (1 John 2:20-27)
6. Gives Assurance of Salvation (Romans 8:14-16)
7. Fills (Ephesians 5:17-21)
8. Leads (Romans 8:14)
9. Imparts Spiritual Gifts (1 Corinthians 12:7, 11)
10. Illuminates Scripture to the Believer (John 14:26; 1 John 2:20, 27)
11. Intercedes for Believers (Romans 8:26)
12. Produces Christ-like character in the Believer (John 7:38; Galatians 5:22-23)
13. Sanctifies (1 Peter 1:2)
14. Inhibits sin (2 Corinthians 3:18; 1 Corinthians 6:11)
15. Empowers the Believer to Witness (Acts 1:8)
16. Comforts and Counsels the Believer (John 14:16; 2 Corinthians 1:3-5)
17. Raises and Changes the Believer's Body (Romans 8:11)
18. Glorifies Jesus Christ (John 16:14).
