Now then, what about us?

Paul authoritatively confronts the distorted Galatian gospel because...

A. The gospel Paul preaches is from Jesus (11-16)

B. His calling as an apostle is from Jesus (17-24)

God saves sinners through the gospel, so the church must single-mindedly protect and proclaim it.

### **REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS:**

Read Galatians 1:11-24.

**Monday:** It is not just the responsibility of church leaders to protect and proclaim the gospel message; it's the responsibility of each member. What are a few ways you could faithfully protect the gospel message? Discuss this with a close friend.

**Tuesday:** Now, what are a few ways you could grow in proclaiming the gospel boldly? Discuss this with a close friend.

**Wednesday:** Paul's ministry was characterized by a singular purpose; to glorify God by making Christ known. Prayerfully your life and ministry. Without adding anything new to your calendar, how can your life be better marked by this singular purpose?

**Thursday:** The churches praised God because Paul was preaching the faith he once tried to destroy. His life now reflected a heart changed by Jesus, consistent with the message he preached. What areas of your life may not reflect the gospel message you proclaim?

**Friday:** Take some time to pray about people groups who have no access to Christians or the gospel message. What is God asking you to do with regards to this "gospel starvation?"

**Saturday:** Read Galatians 2:1-10 and bring a friend tomorrow!
