REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

Monday: Read Galatians 4:12a. Name one way you need to “be like Paul” (trusting in Christ alone)?

Tuesday: Read Galatians 4:12b-16. Why is it difficult to hear truth from our siblings in Christ? Name one way you might invite this type of input into your life on a regular basis.

Wednesday: Read Galatians 4:17-18. Who wishes to prevent you from trusting in Christ alone? How might you respond to them?

Thursday: Read Galatians 4:17-18. Name one spiritual authority you can “eagerly seek in a commendable manner.” Name one way to do so.

Friday: Read Galatians 4:19-20. The point of repentance, of “changing our minds,” is to have Christ formed in us. Name one way you need to be formed into His likeness, and one way He is currently forming you.
