"The one who is taught the word is to share all good things with the one who teaches *him*." (Galatians 6:6)

_____ with the Lord of the harvest.

"⁷Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. ⁸For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life." (Galatians 6:7-8)

_____ in doing good to all people.

"⁹Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary. ¹⁰So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith." (Galatians 6:9-10)

REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

Monday: Read Galatians 6:6-10 three times and note repeated words and phrases, commands, and promises. Summarize the message of the text in a sentence.

Tuesday: How does this passage tie-in with the key themes of Galatians (see Gal 2:16, 5:13, and 6:15)?

Wednesday: What does it mean to sow to the flesh and the Spirit (see Gal 5:13-24)? How can you apply this?

Thursday: Reflect on Gal 6:9. What does Paul mean when he speaks of losing "heart in doing good"? Can you relate to this?

Friday: Read Gal 6:6-10. Where do you see evidence of the Word of God, the Spirit of God and the people of God?

Saturday: Read Gal 6:11-18. Pray for mothers around the world, that they will be blessed tomorrow!
