REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

Wednesday: Google "Paul's First Missionary Journey." Choose a map to look at while you read Acts 13:1-12. What do you learn about Paul's strategy for advancing the gospel? Note where he went, what he did, and who went with him. Who is God calling you to reach out to?

Thursday: Read Acts 13:4-12. Contrast how Bar-Jesus and Sergius Paulus responded to the gospel and how Barnabas and Saul responded to these men. How does this apply to us?

Friday: Read Acts 13:1-3. What are three characteristics of the Antioch church? How might the church at Cherrydale follow the example of the church at Antioch?
