

“For I Am With You”

Acts 18:1-17

REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

Monday: Read Acts 18:1-4. What “trade” has God allowed you to do (v. 3)? How might you use it for ministry? Name one way you could use your day(s) of rest for reaching the lost (v. 4).

Tuesday: Read Acts 18:5. Does your present lifestyle (vacation, break from school, independently wealthy, supported by parents, retired) allow for full-time ministry? Name one way you could use your time to testify “that Jesus [is] the Christ.”

Wednesday: Read Acts 18:6-8. Are there people in your life that resist and blaspheme Jesus? Maybe it’s time to move on. Name one person in your life that might be more receptive, and a way to prioritize time with them, that they might believe.

Thursday: Read Acts 18:9-11. We often let fear silence us. Name one fear you have the hinders you from sharing the gospel and bring this before God today. Ask him to help you share the word of God in the sphere of influence in which he’s placed you.

Friday: Read Acts 18:12-17. Unbelievers often show hostility or utter apathy. Pray for them today, the opponents of the gospel, and those completely disinterested, that God might soften their hearts and bring them to repentance and saving faith in Jesus.

Saturday: Read Acts 18:18-28 and bring a friend tomorrow morning!
