Reflection questions:

Monday: Read Eccl 6:10-7:14. What do 6:10-12 and 7:13-14 have in common? What are the key words in 7:1-12? How is the passage a call to a God-centered life?

Tuesday: Read Eccl 6:10-12. What realities about God does this passage point to? How is it related to Genesis 1-3? How does it compare to Romans 8:18-20?

Wednesday: Read Eccl 7:1-12. Identify every reference to the terms better, wisdom, foolishness, and heart. How are the commands in the passage fulfilled in Jesus (1 Corinthians 1:30)?

Thursday: Read Eccl 7:1-12 again. How do the exhortations to wisdom find their fulfillment in Jesus? (Luke 9:23-24; Matthew 6:24).

Friday: Read Eccl 7:13-14. How is the work of God fulfilled in Jesus? (John 5:17; 6:29; Rom 8:31-32) How did he face the ultimate adversity for us?

Saturday: Read Eccl 7:15-29. Discover its major theme, pray for our services tomorrow, and bring a friend with you to church.
