How to Live Wisely with Authorities and Mysteries

#9 The Quest

Ecclesiastes 8:1-17

Reflection questions

Monday: Read Eccl 8:1-17 and identify the themes in 8:1-11 and 8:12-17. Look for repetition of words and principles that have been already revealed.

Tuesday: Read Eccl 8:1-11 and discover how to wisely relate to authorities. What insights can you discover about exercising authority and relating properly to authorities? How did Jesus model this?

Wednesday: Read Eccl 8:12-17 and discover how to live with vanities and mysteries in a fallen world. What does the passage reveal about God? People? How to live in line with the realities of life?

Thursday: Read Eccl 8:15 and discover the parallel “enjoy life as a gift” passages in the book. How can you apply this? How did Jesus teach the same principle?

Friday: Read Eccl 8:16-17 and discover the other “we cannot discover” passages. Why is it important to accept this reality? How does this move us to fear God? How does it relate to what Jesus taught in Matthew 6:25-34?

Saturday: Read Eccl 9:1-11 and discover what it says about God, people and how to live. Pray for your church family and bring a friend with you to church tomorrow.
