REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Monday: Read Matt 6:19-24 and identify the three key sections of the passage and the big idea of each. Look for key words, contrasts, and commands.

Tuesday: Read Matt 6:19-21. What kind of treasure does God want us to have? How can we obtain it? How do we develop “treasure in heaven” kind of hearts?

Wednesday: Read Matt 6:22-23. How does what is said in 6:19-21 and 6:24 impact your understanding of 6:22-23? Salvation is about finding a new heart treasure and new master. How does salvation impact how we see the world?

Thursday: Read Matt 6:24. How can money be our master? Do you believe every human has a master? What are the implications for how we should live?

Friday: Read Matt 6:19-24 again and turn each of the three sections of the text into specific applications. Anchor your applications in your union with Christ and depend on the Holy Spirit as you apply the truth.

Saturday: Read Matt 6:25-34 and bring a friend with you to learn how to deal with anxiety and worry.
