REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Monday: Read Matthew 7:1-29 and consider immediate context of Matt 7:7-12. What are the key themes of chapter 7 and how does 7:7-12 fit with the theme?

Tuesday: Read Matt 7:7-12. What does the passage tell you about God and people? What are promises to claim, sins to avoid, examples to follow and commands to obey?

Wednesday: Read Matt 7:7-12. What questions about unanswered prayer does this passage provoke? How does knowing God's character and the gospel shape your response to unanswered prayer?

Thursday: Read Matt 7:7-12. Are you diligently asking, seeking and knocking? Why or why not? What motivators to do so are given in the passage?

Friday: Read Matt 7:12. How does the therefore in the passage connect to what Jesus said just before this text? Why are loving God and people always connected (Matt 22:37-40)? How does the gospel of Christ impact our love for God and others (2 Corinthians 5:14-21)?

Saturday: Read Matt 7:13-23 and pray for someone to invite to church with you on Sunday.
