REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Monday- Read Matt 5-7 and capture the essential message of the Sermon on the Mount. What does the sermon reveal about how Jesus viewed Himself, the nature of people, how to enter to kingdom of God, and how to miss entering it?

Tuesday- Read Matt 7:13-29 which is the conclusion of Jesus' sermon. What commands, warnings, and assurances does Jesus give? Have you entered the narrow gate (Matt 7:13-14)? Do you know Jesus Christ in a way that shapes your life (Matt 7:23)?

Wednesday- Read Matt 7:24-27. Compare and contrast the two people Jesus mentions. How does Psalm 1:1-6 and John 6:29 inform your understanding of Jesus' closing analogies?

Thursday- Read Matt 7:24-27. How does John 8:31-32, James 1:21-25 and 2 Peter 1:1-11 help you understand what Jesus meant by hearing and obeying His word?

Friday- Read Matt 7:28-29. Why were the crowds amazed at Jesus' sermon? What amazes you about His sermon? Is Jesus the authority in your life? According to the Sermon on the Mount, how would one know if Jesus is the authority in their life?

Saturday- Read Mark 16:1-20 and 1 Corinthians 15:1-10. Renew your hope in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead and bring a friend with you to church this Easter.
