Reflection and Application Questions

Monday- Read Luke 18:1-8 and answer the following questions: What does the passage say about God and people? What are sins to avoid, commands to obey, promises to claim, and examples to follow?

Tuesday- Read the following six “don’t lose heart” passages: Luke 18:1; 2 Corinthians 4:1,16; Galatians 6:9; Ephesians 3:13; Hebrews 12:3; 2 Thessalonians 3:13, and discover God’s “strong heart” provisions.

Wednesday- Read Luke 18:1-7. What questions did Jesus ask and why? How is God contrasted with the selfish judge? How are we contrasted with the desperate widow?

Thursday- Read Luke 18:1-8. What is the significance of the term elect? (It is found 22 times in the New Testament). How do John 6:44; 1 John 5:13 and Romans 8:1 help you be confident in being elect?

Friday- In verse 8, what is the significance of the words “quickly” and “Son of Man comes”? Jesus was only weeks away from His death and resurrection, and this indeed was justice for His people quickly.

Saturday – Read Matthew 13:1-23 and bring a friend with you to church on Sunday.
