#11 Parables of Jesus

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### REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

**Monday-** Read Luke 12:1-33 and discover the context of Luke 12:13-21. What is before and after the parable of Jesus? Keep in mind Jesus' mission as described in Luke 19:10.

**Tuesday-** Read Luke 12:13-21. What does the passage say about God and people? What key terms are repeated and what is overall theme of the passage?

**Wednesday-** Read 1 Timothy 6:6-11 and James 4:13-5:8. How do the themes in these passages correspond with the theme of Luke 12:13-21? What is the driving motivation behind the commands of the passage? How does your union with Jesus Christ help you apply the passages?

**Thursday-** Read Luke 12:13-21. What command did Jesus give and why? What did the rich fool believe about life? Why did God call him a fool?

**Friday-** Read Luke 12:13-21. What does it mean to be rich toward God? How does the context of the passage (Luke 12:1-12 and 12:22-34) reveal what being rich toward God looks like? How do the truths of Philippians 2:1-13, Colossians 3:1-17, and 2 Corinthians 8:1-15 help you become rich toward God?

**Saturday-** Read Matthew 25:31-46 in preparation for tomorrow's worship service and invite a friend to join you at church.
