REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Monday- Read Matt 25:1-46. What do the two parables and the description of the last judgment have in common? How do they differ? What is the primary application for each?

Tuesday- Read Matt 25:31-46. How many times is Jesus referred to and what titles are assigned to Him? Read Revelation 20:11-15 and John 5:22-29. Describe the final judgment and the basis of our hope.

Wednesday- Read Matt 25:31-46. Make a chart contrasting and comparing the sheep and the goats. What titles are given to each? What is the eternal destiny of each? Does this passage teach that how we treat Jesus will determine our eternal destiny? Why or why not?

Thursday- Read Matt 25:31-46. What are the six actions or lack of action of “sheep and goat people” toward others? Read Isaiah 58, 1 John 3, and Matt 22:37-40. How does faith in Christ compel us to serve others?

Friday- Read Romans 3:21-26; Ephesians 2:8-9; Galatians 3:1-9 (don’t make the mistake of believing you are saved by works instead of by faith alone). Read Eph 2:10; Philippians 2:12-13; James 2:18-26 (don’t make the mistake of believing you are saved by faith that does not work). We are saved by faith alone but faith that saves is not alone – it works.

Saturday- Read Matt 18:21-35. This would be a great Sunday to bring a friend with you to church.
